The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate or replace the existing bridge carrying Rayon Drive over the Jackson River.

Upon completion of the project the bridge's structurally deficient status and load posting will be eliminated. This will allow the City of Covington to better market the area for economic development and nearby residents will have improved access.

Currently, several alternatives for bridge replacement are being reviewed by the consultant design team.

These alternatives will receive feedback from VDOT and the City of Covington. Afterwards, one alternative will be chosen to continue to full design.

The advertisement Date is planned for April of 2026. The ultimate cost will depend on the alternative chosen, however, the following costs using State of Good Repair funding have been programmed for this project:

Rural Rustic Roads

The Rural Rustic Road program provides paving to qualifying secondary roads. All work to be completed within the existing right of way. The road surface is generally widened to 16 to 18 feet, drainage is improved and the road receives a surface treatment pavement.
