This project is located in the Town of Hot Springs in Bath County.

The project will widen existing sidewalks along Route 615 (Main Street) to the Route 220 (Sam Snead Highway) intersection. Crosswalk improvements with a rapid flashing beacon, which can be activated with a push button, will be installed.

Lighting will also be provided at this intersection with this project.

Rural Rustic Roads

The Rural Rustic Road program provides paving to qualifying secondary roads. All work to be completed within the existing right of way. The road surface is generally widened to 16 to 18 feet, drainage is improved and the road receives a surface treatment pavement.
