Notice to Bidders of eVA

The Governor has determined that all commerce with the Commonwealth of Virginia will utilize one central procurement portal that is common to all agencies. It is called *eVa* for electronic-Virginia. It is operated under the direction of the Department of General Services (DGS), All proposals contain a provision similar to the following:

Section 102 <u>eVA BUSINESS-TO-GOVERNMENT VENDOR REGISTRATION</u>: The eVA Internet electronic procurement solution, web site portal <u>www.eVA.virginia.gov</u> streamlines and automates government purchasing activities in the Commonwealth. The portal is the gateway for vendors to conduct business with state agencies and public bodies. All vendors shall participate in the eVA Internet e-procurement solution either through the eVA Basic Vendor Registration Service or eVA Premium Vendor Registration Service. All bidders must register in eVA <u>prior to award</u> of any contracts. **Failure to register will result in the contract not being awarded**.

- a. eVA Basic Vendor Registration Service Includes: electronic order receipt, vendor catalog posting, on-line registration, electronic bidding and the ability to research historical procurement data available in the eVA purchase transaction data werehouse.
- b. eVA Premium Vendor Registration Service Includes: all benefits of the eVA Basic Vendor Registration Service plus automatic email or fax notification of solicitations and amendments.
