Find out about a proposed project to construct transportation improvements in the Hydraulic Road and U.S. 29 area. The project includes a pedestrian bridge over U.S. 29 with bus stops and shelters near Zan Road, a signalized pedestrian crossing and reconfigured traffic movements at the Hydraulic and U.S. 29 intersection, reconstruction of the Angus Road and U.S. 29 intersection into a "green tee", reconstruction of the Hillsdale and Hydraulic Road intersection into a roundabout, and access management improvements at the Hydraulic Road/Brandywine Drive and Hydraulic Road/Michie Drive intersections.

Review the proposed project plans and the environmental documentation in the form of a Categorical Exclusion at the public hearing or at two VDOT office locations: VDOT's Culpeper District Office located at 1601 Orange Road, Culpeper, VA 22701, 540-829-7500 or 1-800-367-7623 and VDOT's Charlottesville Residency, located at 701 VDOT Way, Charlottesville, VA 22911, 434-293-0011.
