Comments must be postmarked, emailed or delivered to VDOT by **October 20, 2019** in order to be included in the public hearing record.

After the public comment period closes, VDOT will review and evaluate any information received as a result of this hearing. This information, including the hearing

summary, will be available for review at the VDOT Culpeper District office. After all comments have been addressed, the information received as a result of the hearing will be presented to VDOT's District Engineer or designee for consideration. If approval of the major design features is received for this project, it will move forward to the final design phase.

Welcome to the Virginia Department of Transportation's design public hearing on the proposed roadway improvements on Broadview Avenue in the Town of Warrenton.

This public hearing is being held to provide an opportunity for any person, acting on his/her own behalf or representing a group or governing agency, to give VDOT comments and/or suggestions on the proposed project.

VDOT strives to ensure that all members of the community have the opportunity to participate in public decisions on transportation projects and programs affecting them. VDOT representatives are present to discuss the project and answer your questions.

A comment sheet is included in the handout for this meeting, and your input is encouraged. All oral and written comments received on this project will be included in a transcript for review by VDOT personnel, citizens and other interested parties.

Project Overview

Anticipated Cost – \$8.6 million

Purpose – Improve safety, maintain access to businesses, reduce traffic congestion and improve aesthetics of the corridor

Location – Intersection of Frost Avenue and Broadview Avenue to 0.81-mile north

Total Length – 0.81 mile

Improvements – Reconstruction of Route 211/ Broadview Ave intersection, signal modifications, install short medians to improve safety and manage access, crosswalk and sidewalk upgrades and 5-foot bike lanes on both sides of the road.
