

Interstate 95 Projects Fredericksburg Area

- I-95 Express Lanes Fredericksburg Extension
- I-95 Rappahannock River Crossing NB and SB
- I-95 Exit 126 Southbound Ramp Improvement
- I-95 Exit 140 Diverging Diamond Interchange (complete)







Building a Better Ride

I-95 Southbound Rappahannock River Crossing

Construction began: August 2018 Construction complete: May 2022 Construction cost: \$132 million

Design-build team: Wagman Heavy Civil and JMT Engineering

- Converts I-95 southbound lanes to three local lanes
- In the median, new construction of 3 lanes for I-95 southbound traffic traveling through Fredericksburg region
- New lanes will start before Route 17 in Stafford County and continue south of Route 3 in City of Fredericksburg and Spotsylvania County
- New I-95 bridge under construction over the Rappahannock River to carry new southbound lanes in the median
- Replaces Route 17 overpasses





Project milestones: Finished

- Project is 60 percent complete
- Replaced Route 17 northbound overpass
- Built new Route 17 southbound median overpass
- Extensive clearing + grading in median
- Intermediate paving in portions of median
- Rappahannock River Crossing bridge piers









What Drivers Can Expect: October 2020




During October 2020, construction will begin to rebuild the final new overpass bridge at Exit 133 (Route 17) in Stafford County, which is the bridge in the I-95 southbound general purpose lanes (far left). The northbound collector-distributor lane bridge (far right) will be replaced as part of the I-95 Northbound Rappahannock River Crossing project.



The project is raising the height of the new I-95 overpasses on Route 17 to avoid strikes and damage from trucks and oversize vehicles passing underneath.





Monday, October 5
New Route 17 temporary
traffic signals start to
flash at I-95


Tuesday, October 7-Wednesday, October 8 (overnight) Exit 133 loop ramps close at overpass

All I-95 southbound traffic traveling to Route 17 uses Exit 133 A ramp

Route 17 northbound traffic uses left turn lane at signal to enter I-95 northbound

Tuesday, October 13 – Wednesday, October 14 I-95 southbound shift to median overpass





7 p.m. Tuesday,
October 13
I-95 southbound
reduced to 2 lanes
near Exit 133

9 p.m. Tuesday, October 13 I-95 southbound reduced to single lane near Exit 133

2 p.m. Wednesday, October 14 All southbound lanes reopen, with traffic traveling over median overpass

I-95 Overpass at Truslow Road: Upcoming Lane Closures



Looking south along I-95 from the 95 Express Lanes work zone to replace the Truslow Road overpass in Stafford County at mile marker 134. Crews will be placing bridge beams to span the travel lanes beginning October 5, weather permitting



I-95 Express Lanes Fredericksburg Extension (FredEx) Truslow Road and American Legion Road Detours, Stafford County

Truslow Road

- Overpass closed January 2020
- Reopens winter 2020/early 2021
- Overpass beams to be placed October 5-9, and then Oct. 14-16, weather permitting
- Expect overnight I-95 lane closures:
 - Northbound, 8 p.m. to 4:30 a.m.
 - Southbound, 8 p.m. to 10 a.m.
 - Full, intermittent stops for up to 30-minute intervals to move crane between midnight and 3 a.m. Friday, Oct. 9 and Friday, Oct. 16

American Legion Road

- Overpass closes in early 2021
- Posted detour will be Route 1 and Centreport Parkway
