





#### **Background**

- High existing and future traffic demands in the Springfield area
- Access modifications along Franconia-Springfield Parkway necessary to provide increased capacity and connectivity
- Frontier Drive Extension is included in Fairfax County's Comprehensive Plan
- Initial Public Information Meeting was held on December 17, 2017.








#### **Design Features**

- A four-lane divided roadway with a new bridge over Long Branch and shared use paths on both sides of the road.
- Braided ramps at the Frontier Drive and Franconia- Springfield Parkway interchange.
- Access improvements to the Franconia-Springfield Metro station.










# Typical Section (South Project Area) Frontier Drive Extension and Braided Ramps Project
















## Loisdale Estates Area Frontier Drive Extension and Braided Ramps Project

### **Estimated Project Cost and Funding**

Project Phase	2021
Preliminary Engineering	\$ 12.6 M
Right of Way / Utility Relocation	\$ 38.5 M
Construction	\$ 129.1 M
Total	\$ 180.2 M

The project is being financed with local and Northern Virginia Transportation Authority (NVTA) regional funds. Fairfax County will be seeking additional funding from various sources for the remaining project phases.

Design Public Hearing	Fall 2021
Design Approval	Winter 2021/2022

Start of right-of-way acquisition, utility relocation, and construction is dependent on funding.


