## PUBLIC HEARING THURSDAY, AUGUST 15, 2019 5 - 7 p.m.



The public hearing will introduce and solicit public input on VDOT's recommendation for a preferred alternative. This is the alternative that VDOT believes is the Least Environmentally Damaging Practicable Alternative (LEDPA). The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers can only permit the LEDPA at the end of this study.
