





WHAT LEVEL OF SERVICE MEANS

Level of Service (LOS) is a measure of traffic flow, with A being the best and F being the worst.




LOS A

Free Flow – Vehicles almost completely unimpeded in their ability to maneuver within the traffic stream




LOS B

Reasonable Free Flow – The ability to maneuver within the traffic stream is only slightly restricted




LOS C

Stable Flow – Freedom to maneuver within the traffic stream is noticeably restricted




LOS D

Approaching Unstable Flow – Freedom to maneuver within the traffic stream is more noticeably limited



LOS E

Unstable Flow – Operations at capacity; no usable gaps in traffic stream



LOS F

Forced or Breakdown Flow – Volumes exceed capacity; queues form behind breakdown point
